Ellis, in partnership with Roswell Park Comprehensive Cancer Center, now delivers advanced and widely accessible medical oncology care to our region. Working closely with Ellis' already established radiation oncology and surgical teams, this groundbreaking partnership brings the third and final pillar of cancer treatment to Ellis Hospital – medical oncology. This means sophisticated care is now accessible close-to-home for the residents of Upstate New York.

Why is having a Roswell Park Care Network site in our community a monumental change for oncology services? Cancer is the only disease Roswell Park physicians and scientists work to cure.

Roswell Park is solely dedicated to the research and treatment of cancer. Their laser focus and emphasis on research means the Roswell team is constantly advancing toward newer, better, and safer ways to treat even the most complex cases.

Roswell has earned the National Cancer Institute (NCI) distinction and is one of only 51 Comprehensive Cancer Centers in the U.S. To receive this distinction from the NCI, centers must meet rigorous standards for transdisciplinary, state-of-the-art research focused on developing new and better approaches to preventing,

diagnosing, and treating cancer. This designation signifies that the Institute has contributed fundamentally to the fight against cancer.

The partnership with Roswell denotes Ellis as a Roswell Park Care Network Member. Our patients will benefit from national best practices and quality care, the latest technology, the most innovative therapies, and the expertise of the most experienced cancer teams. Ellis' site is led by Dr. Tallat Mahmood, a Roswell-employed physician working solely at Ellis Hospital. Dr. Mahmood decided to lead this site based on the plan to make Ellis a "mini Roswell Park." The goal is to grow and enhance oncology services for our community, this is just phase one.

### Sue Zeltmann knows firsthand the role that HOPE can play in a cancer journey.

When Sue's beloved husband Gene was diagnosed in 2018, they both relied on hope to buoy them through the long, difficult treatment process. Gene's treatment, like that of many others, was complicated by a further obstacle—the need to travel outside the region to receive the state-of-theart medical oncology he required.

Ellis' partnership with Roswell Park will now provide the most advanced treatment options right here in our own community, sparing patients and their families logistical stress and increased time away from the comforts of home in their already overwhelming battle.

Sue also understands the hope that Roswell Park represents for patients and their loved ones. The highest quality of care, and the ease with which it can be accessed, will make other patients' cancer experiences vastly easier, with much more reason to hope for the best outcome.

### WE ARE SO THANKFUL TO SUE FOR SHARING HER AND GENE'S STORY:

"When my husband Gene received his devastating diagnosis of Acute Myeloid Leukemia (AML) in May 2017, we were faced with few choices for first-rate oncology treatment other than to take the more than three-hour trip to either Boston or New York City. We chose Dana Farber in Boston.

The doctors and medical staff there were amazing, and they arranged for local treatments for Gene, with occasional trips back to Dana Farber for follow-ups. They never let us give up hope. Although we all knew this was a life-threatening, fatal disease, they gave him the best, most current care while letting us hope for a possible stem-cell transplant, which would help him live a better life for as long as he could.

Unfortunately, it wasn't to be, and he passed away in February 2018.

Now we have the Roswell Park Care Network site in Schenectady partnering with Ellis to treat people like Gene right here at home. How much nicer and easier it will be to have this wonderful facility close to home for people suffering with any cancer diagnosis. How comforting for patients not to have to travel—they can stay close to their families and still receive state-of-the-art oncology care. I know Gene would have loved this option, and Ellis Hospital is to be highly commended for providing it.

Gene was a huge supporter of Ellis Hospital, as well as a board member for five years, and he would be so proud of Ellis for bringing this superior level of care to our area. Thank you, Ellis Hospital."

## TREATING CANCER with radiation

Radiation therapy is often used in conjunction with surgery and chemotherapy to treat certain cancers. And, often, radiation alone is enough to kill cancer cells. Radiation therapy has been a lifesaving program at Ellis since the 1990s, and our community recently supported the purchase of a new linear accelerator (Linac) at Ellis Hospital.

Technology has advanced to the point where our older equipment was unable to offer the most sophisticated treatment. With older technology, more healthy tissue is negatively affected by radiation treatment than necessary, which becomes critical if the tumor is near vital organs. The extreme precision of the new linear accelerator allows doctors to take treatment to the next level.

The new machine allows our physicians to treat patients who previously were not able to receive care locally. The majority of treatments with the older Linac were skin, lung, breast, and prostate cancers. The precision of the new equipment allows Ellis to treat patients with challenging tumor sites in the brain, spine, prostate, liver and lungs.

This new technology also reduces the amount of time a patient is receiving daily care, decreases recovery time, and diminishes associated side effects. Additionally, the new Linac helps to improve access to care by reducing appointment times by one-third and increases the number of patients able to be treated by more than 30%.

"When patients have to travel five days a week for many weeks for treatment, it can be very challenging, both logistically and physically," said Chris Dolinsky, MD, Chief of Radiation Oncology. "And, obviously, we're looking at not only the treatment as being the most advanced but also that we're delivering it in a convenient location: locally, and within Ellis Hospital where they may also be receiving chemotherapy and/or surgery. We believe our role is to provide the most timely, efficient, and effective care for each patient. We take that role seriously."

We are sincerely thankful to the community for their support of this cutting-edge technology. It directly impacts the quality of life that countless patients experience during their cancer journey.

Our goal is to modernize our operating rooms with state-of-the-art equipment, expand on our robotic and minimally invasive procedures and improve flow and circulation around high-tech equipment. Robotic and minimally invasive procedures reduce pain and scarring, shorten healing time, and ensure that patients get back to their lives faster.
